Background

In March 2024 the parish council considered the condition of the dog waste bin at Heathley Lane, Drayton Bassett. The bin is owned by the parish council and emptied on a weekly basis by Lichfield District Council. There is another dog waste bin owned by the Parish Council which is Mayfield Road.

Following a request for additional information concerning costs, the following information was received from Lichfield District Council:

- The annual cost (2023/2024) for emptying the 2 waste bins was £322.40
- The annual cost for emptying the two bins in 2024/2025 is £334.88 + VAT
- If one bin were to be removed this collection fee would be £167.44 + VAT
- Dog waste can be put into any of the public bins for collection however these bins are large and with the quantity of waste already being collected in the village, may prove too heavy for the teams to collect.
- LDC can provide a replacement dog waste bin for £350 + VAT plus £50 + VAT for a post
- Glasdon quote £268.09 + VAT for a 50 litre bin free delivery
- Broxap quote £220 + VAT for a 60 litre bin and fixing post + delivery
